1. National & State Forests

The **Same Houston National Forest** borders on Lake Conroe and is home to the **Lone Star Hiking Trail**, a trail that expands over 128 miles, and is great for fishing, hiking, and birding year-round. The **W. Goodrich Jones State Forest's** nature trail, picnic tables, horseback riding, and fishing make it a perfect day-use destination. Both are fantastic for birding.

2. The Lone Star Flag Park

The **Lone Star Monument and Historical Flag Park** celebrates Texas History with 13 battle flags that flew as Texas won her independence. The outdoor museum also features a 14-foot bronze statue of a common Texas Revolution era soldier known as "The Texian".



3. Lake Conroe

Lake Conroe is a 22,000 acre lake with 157 miles of shoreline. Enjoy fishing, boating, water sports, lakeside dining, and cruising on our authentic riverboat.



4. Heritage Museum

The **Heritage Museum of Montgomery County** features exhibits chronicling the county's roots, from lumber and oil industries to everyday county residents. The museum is housed in a historic home built in 1924.



5. Historic Downtown

Historic downtown Conroe offers antique shopping at **Conroe Central Market, Mimi's on Main, and The Mercantile**. Take a stroll through our **Art Bench Walking Tour** and stop in the **Campobella Bronze Fine Art Studio** or the art gallery at **The Medley Building**.



6. Crichton Theatre & Owen Theatre

Visit our historic vaudeville **Crichton Theatre**, built in 1934 or our art-deco inspired **Owen Theatre**.

7. Local Flavor
